Thank you for your entry to the 2026 KENNOL Grand Prix de France Historique. We are looking forward to getting the Masters 2026 Tour underway at Paul Ricard. 1.2. YOUR RACE ENTRY

The Masters Entry Lists will be published on the [KENNOL Grand Prix de France Historique Event Page](#) of the Masters website. Please check that your entry details are correct and that you know your allocated race number. If you plan to add a co-driver, please let us know ASAP.

1.3. MASTERS RACE INFORMATION APP

Masters has a new App as ever it will be the main information portal for all the Masters grids. We would recommend that if you have not already, you download and register before leaving for Paul Ricard as there is an identification process to complete which requires documentation uploads. All communications during the event will be carried out via the main event chat directly within the app, accessible via this [link](#).

1.4. EVENT NOTICE BOARD

The Official Event Noticeboard for the event will be virtual and can be accessed through the new Masters App.

1.5. ALCOHOL & TOBACCO LIVERY BAN

All forms of alcohol and tobacco advertising are banned in France, with no exception. To comply with French legislation, any car that typically displays alcohol and/or tobacco livery must either cover it, remove it, or change it so that it is not identifiable as promoting any form of alcohol or tobacco products for the duration of the Competition, including private testing. This legislation also applies to all team wear, equipment and transport. Non-compliance will result in the Competitor not being allowed to participate in the Competition.

2. Circuits Access, Paddocks, Tickets and Pit Garages

2.1. TICKETS & PASSES

Tickets will not be issued in advance. These will be issued to you during Administrative Checks on **Thursday from 15:00 to 19:00**. Each team will receive eight tickets and three car passes. Extra passes can be purchased via this [link](#). The Accreditation is located at the **Grand Prix Hôtel**, at the following times:

- **Thursday:** From 07:00 to 19:00
- **Friday & Saturday:** From 07:00 to 13:00

You must collect your passes from here before you access the site. Please note that any teams arriving Wednesday after 17:00 will be directed to Parking G inside the circuit until paddocks open Thursday 13:00. All the paddock set-up, and pit garage load-in must take place on Thursday by 20:00, with no exceptions.

Takedown can only take place from 16:30 on Sunday. After which, teams wishing to stay overnight on Sunday can do so in Parking G (only), where electricity will be provided. Please notify the event organisers if you wish to do so. The rest of the paddock, garages, and parking lots must be vacated by 20:00 on Sunday.

2.3. PRIVATE CARS

Private cars are not allowed in the paddock and must be parked in Competitors' Parking G from Thursday onwards. Competitors' parking is located in 'Parking G'.

2.4. PIT GARAGES

The Garage Plan will be released at the beginning of May. Space is going to be very tight, so please park up considerably and follow the instructions of the Masters Team.

The pit garage keys can be collected from the Reception Desk in the main Pit Building on Thursday from 13:30 to 20:00. You will need to leave a € 50 deposit for the key (cash or card).

Please note that garages must remain open during the pit walks (Saturday from 12:25 to 13:00 and Sunday 13:00 to 13:35).

2.5. MASTERS DRIVERS CLUB

The Masters Drivers Club will be located in the paddock. The opening times will be:

- **Friday 8TH May:** From 08:00 to 23:00
- **Saturday 9TH May:** From 08:00 to 23:00
- **Sunday 10TH May:** From 08:00 to 17:00

VIP passes will be issued by the Masters Team at the Drivers Club front desk. **Each competing driver will receive one hospitality pass (under the driver name) and each entry includes one VIP pass.** Additional passes can be purchased on the [Hospitality page](#) of the Masters website. Along with your VIP pass we will issue daily access wristbands.

3.2. EVENT SIGN-ON

Signing on for the event will take place onsite at the Competitors' Welcome Desk (Lobby of F1 Pit Building) at the following times:

- **Thursday 7TH May:** From 13:30 to 19:00
- **Friday 8TH May:** From 07:45 until 2 hours before your driver's briefing.

3.3. EVENT SCRUTINEERING - CARS

The following times:

- **Thursday & Friday:** From 08:30 until 2h before your drivers briefing.

Scrutineers will come to you in your garage please ensure that driver equipment is with the car for the checks.

3.4. TRACK WALK

The track will be open for a track walk on Thursday from 18.30 to 20.30, not scooters or bikes.

3.5. TRANSPONDERS

Only Chronolec / Tag Heuer or ITS Chrono transponders will work during the race weekend. If you need to hire a transponder for the weekend you can do so via the Timekeeper's Office (Pit Building, ground floor) for 60€.

There will be a separate Team Briefing for **Masters Endurance Legends 1** to cover the re-fuelling regulations for team managers and mechanics. This will be held at 15.00hrs in the Masters Hospitality Tent in the paddock.
