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EVENT-SPECIFIC INFORMATION

YOUR RACE ENTRY	MASTERS RACE INFORMATION APP
The Masters Entry List will be published on the MEXICO Event Page of the Masters Website later this week. Please check that your entry details are correct and that you are aware of your allocated race number – no changes to these are to be made.	This App will be the main information portal for the Masters Support Race at Mexico. Please ensure that you and your team sign up to app via the Apple Store or Google Play: search for Masters Historic Racing and join the Mexico24 group which will be added Monday 21ST.
MEXICO IMMIGRATION REGISTRATION FORM	
MANDATORY FOR ALL ATTENDEES Please note that each person entering Mexico, including all drivers and team members, will need to complete the F1 Foreign Visitor Questionnaire using the following HERE. The deadline for registration is October 16th, 2024. When asked for the Company in the questionnaire, please select 'Other' and put 'Masters Historic Racing'.	Once you have submitted your application, you will need to validate your e-mail address. Then once your application is approved, you will receive a second e-mail with specific instructions, an invitation letter and a couple more documents that you will need to print out and submit to the Mexican authorities upon arrival in Mexico. We suggest you fill in the flight information as it will save you time with migration authorities in Mexico.

CIRCUITS ACCESS, TICKETS AND PADDOCK

TICKETS & PASSES	IMPORTANT - REMINDER ABOUT FORMULA 1 MEDIA RIGHT
You will not be sent your credentials before the event; these must be collected onsite. <i>Credentials are required to enter the Circuit from Wednesday, October 23RD.</i> Formula 1 are not able to confirm when are passes will be ready in Mexico. Please keep an eye on the Masters App for updates about your pass collection. If the passes are not available on Tuesday, we will operate a 'Worker Pass' system on Wednesday which we can issue to you on the day in order to access the paddock. Please note that we will issue all the passes for each team to a team member, who will be asked to sign for them. You can then manage your own allocation of passes within your team.	All pass holders and teams are reminded that by agreeing to have a Formula 1 Accreditation, you are agreeing to the following Media rights: - Filming is permitted only by accredited operators issued with a valid Camera Access identification who are wearing the appropriate Pass and Tabard in the Designated Areas to which the Pass allows access, save that any use or transmission of footage in a manner not specifically authorised in such Pass Holder's accreditation terms is strictly prohibited. - Personal electronic devices (including still image cameras, mobile telephones and other personal communicative devices) are permitted unless otherwise advised, provided that any Recording, Data or Image of the event that is recorded, stored and/or created thereon is used for personal, private and non-commercial purposes only. The use of any such Recording, Data or Image for any form of public advertisement, display, commercial gain or for any other purpose other than as specified in this paragraph is strictly forbidden without FOWC's prior written consent, and will constitute a breach of these T&Cs for which the Pass Holder will be liable. Please ensure that you follow these requirements and you do not use your phones for any business marketing purposes at any point during the weekend. We do not wish to have to confiscate any passes for breaches of these conditions.



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Paddock Access, Load-in & Parking

The Masters Support Paddock is in close proximity to the Main Grandstand in the Green Zone which is 290 metres from the main track. Pedestrian access is via public Gate 6 or Gate 7. No vehicle access will be permitted – Taxis will be able to drop you at Gate P6.

The Support Paddock is a purpose-built awning to accommodate all our cars. The paddock will have water and a 150 Kva generator with (11) 110v Quad boxes.

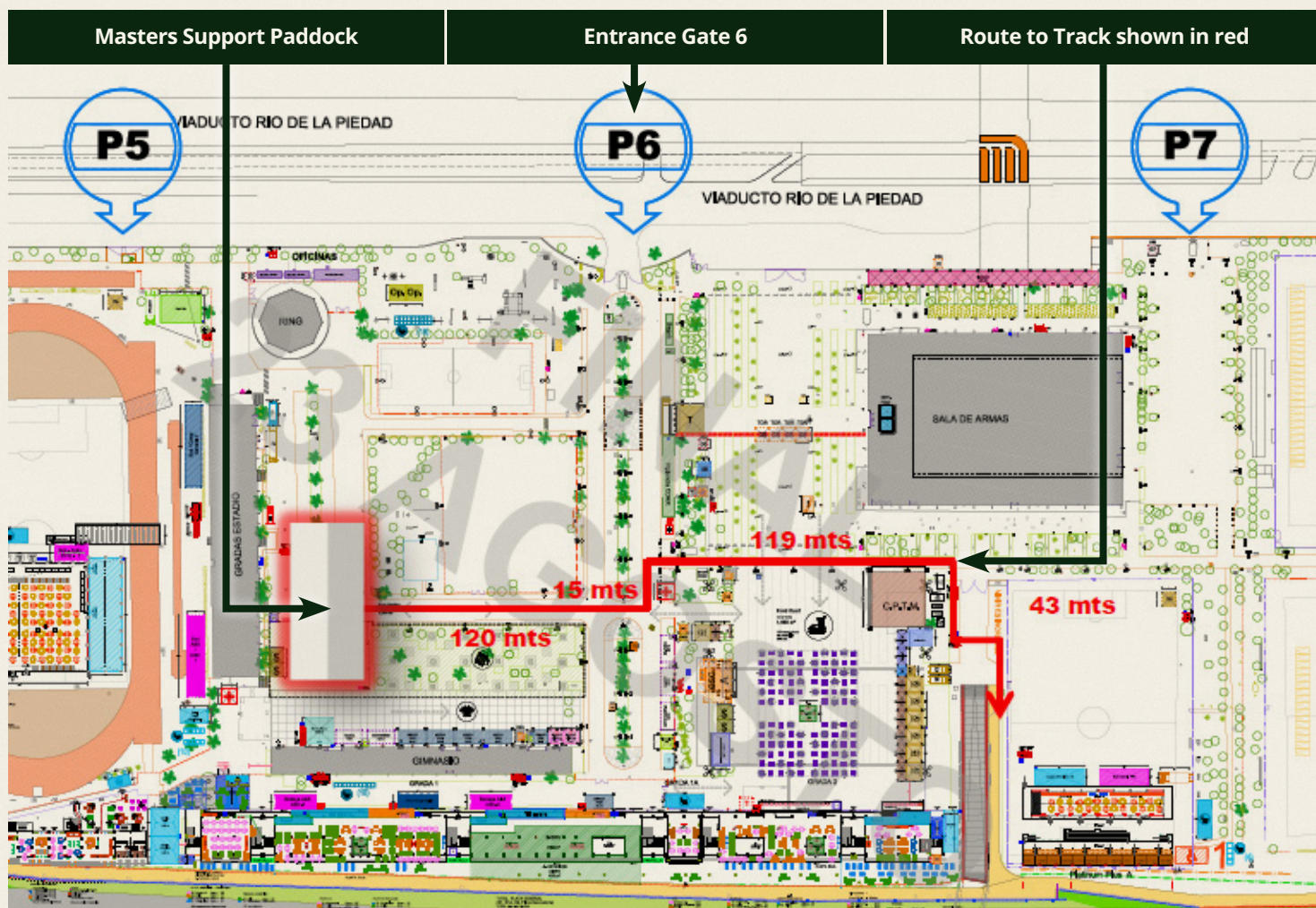
Paddock Load-in will be managed by Circuit Staff and Silver Tiger Logistics.

The cars will arrive at the circuit on the evening of Tuesday, 22ND October. They will be ready for teams to unload and set up from the morning of Wednesday 23RD October.

The Support Paddock has access to dedicated serviced toilet facilities.

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SECURITY

Please note that 24-hour security will be provided in the Support Paddock from midnight on Tuesday, 22ND October, to midnight on Sunday, 27TH October.

The Support Race Paddock will be open to VIP Tours during the weekend, so please ensure your cars are nicely displayed and your equipment is tidy.

GOLF KART USAGE

Golf karts with one personnel will be able to transport equipment only to the pit lane. Passes to enable access for the golf karts to move in and out of the venue are not available.

SCRUTINEERING & TECHNICAL INSPECTION Scrutineering will take place in situ at the following times: Thursday 24TH October: 09.00 am – 6.00 pm Please ensure your car and driver equipment are available and comply with the requirements for this race – see the link to the race regulations HERE.	DRIVERS EQUIPMENT It is mandatory for all entries to wear an FIA-approved head restraint system in accordance with FIA Appendix L, Chapter III.
DRIVERS BRIEFING Attendance is compulsory for all Drivers and their Team Managers – You must sign-in in at arrival: Friday 25TH October: 08.00 am <i>If you are unable to attend the Drivers Briefing, please let us know in advance. You must have a briefing before you go out on track!</i> Further Drivers Meetings may be called during the weekend if needed.	CIRCUIT ORIENTATION There will be an on-track orientation for drivers and team representatives on Thursday. The circuit will be open for access from 9.00 am – 11.45 am, where you will be allowed to walk/run around – please note that no vehicle access will be allowed.

ONBOARD CAMERAS Cars may NOT carry any form of onboard camera at any point during the event as it is strictly prohibited by Formula 1. Please ensure you remove any evidence of on-board cameras or recording equipment before your first session on track. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS Pit-to-car radios may be used but you must ensure you have submitted your Team Name Radio Make & Model Frequency Power Bandwidth to Rachel ASAP. PIT LANE ATTIRE Please ensure that all personnel working in the pit lane are smartly and professionally presented at all times. Long trousers and fully covered shoes are compulsory for all personnel in the pit lane.



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TOBACCO LIVERY	TRANSPONDERS
Formula 1 will not allow any Masters cars to carry any form of tobacco livery advertising on the race cars, overalls or team kit. This rule will be strictly enforced. Therefore, all tobacco brands must be removed or covered on both cars and team wear. If you have a tobacco-liveried car, it is the sole responsibility of the Driver/Entrant to ensure that the team complies with legislation.	Formula 1 is providing timing. The timekeepers will come to the Masters paddock prior to the first session to check if your transponder is working. If it is not, they will issue you with a transponder for the weekend. Please ensure you return any borrowed transponder before leaving the circuit on Sunday.

	We will have an official drivers photo in our paddock during the weekend. Please keep an eye on the Masters App messages for confirmation of time and location.

TYRE SERVICE	FUEL
There will not be a tyre supply and fit service in Mexico. Please ensure that you have your all your necessary tyres in advance. Sasco Sports and GoodYear will be in Austin to get everything organised in advance of Mexico.	Paul Oil Company will deliver fuel drums to the circuit on Wednesday, October 23rd. Please ensure you have pre-ordered your fuel by Monday 14th, October using the order form link HERE or by contacting Paul Oil Company at smurphy@pauloilcompany.com. You may refuel your car in the Masters Paddock. While fuelling, one of your crew members must have a fire extinguisher at hand. We strongly recommend that this crew member also wear flame-retardant clothing.
