CIRCUITS ACCESS, PADDOCKS, TICKETS AND PIT GARAGES

TICKETS & PASSES	ACCESS
You will be emailed a PDF parking pass before the event. Please share this PDF with your team. Each vehicle entering the circuit must present a PDF Pass for access. Upon arrival, this pass will be exchanged for a relevant sticker, according to the vehicle's function. Please ensure private cars are parked in the Orange Paddock Area (See map below). Personnel wristbands for access during the weekend will be issued at signing-on.	Access will only be via the Blanchimont Entrance Gate. The Blanchimont Entrance Gate will be open at the following times: • Tuesday 24TH: 20:30 – 22:30 • Wednesday 25TH: 07:00 – 22:30 • Thursday 26TH: 07:00 – 22:30

All Masters entries should be based in the F1 Pit Garage Area (if space has been booked and confirmed) or the Red Paddock Area.





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PIT GARAGES

The Parking Plan for the F1 Pit Garage has been created with the Spa Six Hours organisers and HGPCA. The final plan will be sent to you later this week. Please ensure you park up as per the plan and park considerately. Space is always tight in the F1 Pit Garage Area. For those who have booked spaces, note that the event promoter, Roadbook, will take payment for garage bookings after the event.

MOTORHOME VILLAGE

If you wish to bring your motorhome you will need to have submitted the **Motorhome Booking Form** to Anne (**paddock@roadbook.net**) to reserve a space ahead of arrival. The cost is 50 Euro per motorhome. Note that there are a limited supply of electrical hookups and these will be available on a first come, first-served basis. The Motorhome Village will be located next to the F1 Grandstands in front of the F1 Pit Garages.

MASTERS' DRIVERS CLUB

The Masters' Drivers Club will be on-site and located in the Red Paddock over the weekend.

The opening times will be:

- **Thursday:** 08:00 – 21:00
- **Friday:** 08:00 – 21:30
- **Saturday:** 08:00 – 16:30

As a new initiative for Spa and considering the late sessions on the timetable, we will also offer you some extra hospitality as part of your entry fee. Next to the Masters Drivers Club will be a food truck, providing hot food for you later each day. The food truck will have lunch from 11:45 – 14:30, afternoon snacks from 16:00 – 17:30 and dinner from 18:30 – 21:00 (Thursday and Friday only). When you collect your VIP wristbands from our Welcome Desk, you will also be given your vouchers.

Each driver is entitled to 2 VIP Drivers Club passes. If you have more than one entry, you are entitled to an additional VIP Club pass per extra entry. Please note that the VIP passes are reserved for Masters Drivers, their guests and team principals only. PRE-EVENT TESTING

There will be untimed open practice on Wednesday, September 25th. To take part, cars must comply with a max permitted noise of 107 dba at exhaust (103 dba on track).

You will receive a car Scrutineering Form at Sign On. • Scrutineering will be carried out in situ for all cars in F1 Pit Garages. • Cars based in the Red Paddock will need to go to the scrutineering area within that paddock at the following times: • Wednesday: 08:15 – 18:30 • Thursday: Priority will be given to grids according to their qualifying session time.		You will receive an Inspection of Equipment Form at Sign On. All driver equipment (HANS, overall, underwear, gloves etc) must be checked for safety before drivers go on track. This will be done in Room 131, 1st Floor F1 Pit Building at the following times: • Wednesday: 08:00 – 11:45 & 12:30 – 18:30 • Thursday & Friday: From 08:00 until 60 minutes before your first track session	
TRANSPONDERS		RADIO USAGE	
Transponders will be checked at sign-on – only AMB transponders are allowed at this event. The cost for the rental is 30 Euros, and cash or card is accepted.		Please note that each team using radio communication equipment must purchase a permit from the Belgian authorities to use their equipment. The permit may be inspected at any time by the Belgian communication authorities, who can issue on-the-spot fines for non-compliance. If you have not yet applied, please do so here.
