2. Competitor Sign-On & Tickets

2.1. TICKET COLLECTION AND SIGN-ON

Upon arrival at the circuit please visit the **Competitor's eception desk** (paddock entrance, ground floor in glass fronted office) which is open Thursday 10TH September 14:00-19:30 and Friday (11TH), Saturday (12TH), Sunday (13TH) from 08:00. Here you will collect your passes, sign on and have your licence checked.

Additional passes can be purchased for €35 each at the Competitor reception desk.

5.1. CIRCUIT

- **Circuit:** Circuit Dijon-Prenois
- **Circuit Length:** 3.801 km
- **Pit Lane Speed Limit:** TBC in the event regulations / briefing
- **Noise Restrictions:** Circuit standard is 100 dB maximum (dynamic measurement); any event-specific requirements will be confirmed in the final instructions.

5.2. MOTORHOMES & TRAILERS

Motorhomes to be parked to the west of the paddock area as per the paddock plan. There is limited water and electrical supply arrangements.

6. Information for Teams

6.1. TRUCK PADDOCK ACCESS

Race trucks to be parked behind garages as per the garage plan which can be seen here. Early arrival from **Wednesday 9th September after 16:00 at Paddock 4** (please note there are no toilets or showers).

6.3. GARAGE PLAN

6.4. PARKING
All private cars must be parked in competitor's parking when you arrive at the circuit.
6.5. SCRUTINEERING
The safety scrutineering team will come to the cars in their garages between 08:00 and 14:00 on Friday 11th September . Driver safety equipment will be checked at this time so please leave with the car. Equipment must comply with current FIA Appendix L requirements.
6.6. TRANSPONDERS
Transponders must be Chronolec / Tag Heuer (Elite or Cobra 360) they can be hired from the 3 RD floor of the race control tower, the cost is €60 for the weekend and there is a €300 deposit by cheque or credit card. The briefing is on the 1 ST floor of the exhibition stand building. The Masters Racing Legends briefing will be held at 10:00 on Friday 11th September .
